MOTION REQUESTING AN ENLARGEMENT OF TIME

COMES NOW Complaint Counsel for the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (“Complaint Counsel”), and moves, pursuant to 16 C.F.R. § 1025.32(b), for an enlargement of time to respond to Baby Matters’ First Interrogatories and Baby Matters’ First Request for Production of Documents and Things (collectively, “Discovery Requests”) filed by Respondent on December 26, 2012. Complaint Counsel’s response to the Discovery Requests is due on January 31, 2013. Complaint Counsel estimates that there are over 8,000 emails and over 1,000 documents that are potentially responsive to Respondent’s Discovery Requests, and Complaint Counsel is working diligently to collect, process, and, where appropriate, produce the requested information to Respondent.

Moreover, Complaint Counsel has filed a Motion for Leave to Amend the Complaint, and requests that the Court rule on that Motion before Discovery is underway. The original complaint was filed on December 4, 2012, and an extension of time to respond to discovery requests will not prejudice the defendant, nor unduly delay these proceedings.

Complaint Counsel requests a short continuance of 45 days in order to respond fully to Respondent’s Discovery Requests.
