Order Denying Complaint Counsel’s Motion to Transmit Proposed Amended Complaint to the Commission and Granting Additional Time to Submit Further Briefing

Upon consideration of the Complaint Counsel’s Motion to Transmit Proposed Amended Complaint to the Commission dated February 14, 2022, and Respondent’s Opposition dated February 16, 2022, it is hereby ordered that: 1) Complaint Counsel’s request to transmit the proposed Amended Complaint to the Commission is denied; 2) the Complaint Counsel’s Motion to Transmit is construed as a Motion to Amend Complaint; 3) Complaint Counsel and Respondent shall have the opportunity to submit additional legal briefing on the Motion to Amend Complaint ten days from the latter of the completion date of Mr. Mauro Carneiro’s deposition and the date on which Respondent responds to Complaint Counsel’s February 9 discovery requests; 4) upon completion of the parties’ briefing, a Decision and Order will be issued on Complaint Counsel’s Motion to Amend, pursuant to 16 C.F.R. § 1025.13; and 5) in the interim, the parties should submit a Joint Motion to update Respondent’s name from thyssenkrupp Access Corp. (“TKA”) to TK Access Solutions Corp. (“TKAS”) if there remains no contest that the name should be changed in this proceeding.
