SUMMARY:

This meeting was a scheduled meeting of the National Electrical Safety Foundation board. Mr. King was an invited guest to discuss electrical safety communication materials for consumers. Mr. King suggested and supported including new information for consumers with regard to lighting (including lamps that use tubular halogen bulbs), batteries (including powerful types used in childrens' products such as ride-on toys), and ground-fault circuit-interrupters (GFCIs). Mr. King also suggested updating the pamphlet done in cooperation with the CPSC entitled "A Home Electrical Safety Check". There was general consensus to undertake these tasks. Updating the pamphlet may be considered as a 1998 program activity by the NESF.
