**SUMMARY OF TELEPHONE CALL:** Mr. Smith told Mr. Wilson about ATV industry concern about the breadth of the request for information contained in the letter of the Commission's General Counsel. Mr. Wilson noted that there would be a meeting of ATV industry representatives with the General Counsel on Thursday and that the ATV industry representatives could identify the portions of the request that they considered burdensome and propose some other document and record production. Mr. Wilson also remarked that the Federal Register notice announcing the transmission of the ATV exposure survey to OMB had been published last Friday and that the results of the exposure survey were likely to be important in any eventual Commission decision about what course of action to take with respect to ATV's.
