R. E. Little Negative Votes on F15 (99-02) Ballot, Items 1 and 2

The F15 (99-02) ballot on Items 1 and 2 is fraudulent. There was no F15.06 subcommittee letter ballot before sending these items to the main committee for ballot. Moreover there was no quorum at the October 29, 1998 F15.06 subcommittee meeting at which the decision was reached to proceed to a F15 main committee letter ballot. Thus the October 29, 1998 F15.06 subcommittee actions regarding my proposed revisions of these items is invalid -- as are the revisions of F-589 on the present F15 main committee ballot.

Despite the fact that both the ASTM headquarter staff liaison person for F15.06 and the F15 main committee chairman refused to give me the subcommittee membership list, it is obvious that no quorum existed at the October 29, 1999 F15.06 subcommittee meeting. They have denied me access to the F15.06 and F15 membership lists because they assert the right to "screen" my proposed correspondence with F15.06 and F15 members regarding my proposed revisions of F-589 and/or F-590 before deciding whether to permit its discrimination. This denial also prevents me from counting the number of subcommittee members and examining their respective subcommittee voting rights and classifications versus their affiliations. Clearly this is not the behavior of a profession society with integrity. But unfortunately it is consistent with its past behavior.

To show that there no quorum existed at the the October 29, 1999 F15.06 subcommittee meeting, I assert the following: First, 8 or 9 of the 12 people attending the meeting are clearly affiliated with companies that belong to the Non-Powder Gun Producers Association (NPGPA): Crosman, Daisy, Beeman, Marksman (and perhaps SIR Industries, Inc). But at least 4 of these 9 do not have a subcommittee F15.06 vote according to ASTM by-laws. Moreover, if Mr. Jereckos has resigned from subcommittee F15.06 in addition to resigning as its chairman, then Crosman must designate someone to exercise their voting rights, and this change must be approved by the F15 Executive Subcommittee prior to the first F15.06 meeting at which this voting right is exercised. Second, the CPSC representative does not have a vote. Third, even the F15 chairman likely does not have a subcommittee vote. He was not a member of subcommittee F15.06 (to my knowledge) before this membership list became pseudo-secret. Thus, there are at most 7 legitimate votes, and likely only 5. Since producers cannot be in the majority of the subcommittee, it is mathematically impossible to have a F15.06 quorum with 5 to 7 legitimate subcommittee votes. (Note also the F15.06 minutes for the October 29, 1999 meeting discretely do not enumerate the number of negative and affirmative votes regarding my proposed revisions -- likely because this enumeration would have clearly indicated the lack of a quorum. I have a complete set of F15.06 meeting, except for one meeting at which it was decide to publish the so-called safety specification without resolving the negative subcommitte votes. These minutes, if taken, were evidently

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misplaced or destroyed. All other votes at task group and subcommittee meetings are enumerated by the number of ayes, nays and abstentions.)

These so-called safety specifications resulted from collusion between the USCPSC, ASTM, and NPGPA that led to the formation of the F15.06 task group. Examination of the F15.06 task group and subcommittee minutes indicates clearly that spirit and/or letter of the ASTM by-laws were violated and/or ignored during the development of these so-called safety standards, and during each of their subsequent revisions. Unfortunately this devious activity continues to this day. In fact, this is *second* fraudulent attempt in the last year to sneak the re-approval of these so-called safety standards on a F15 main committee ballot.

My objective in wishing to write to all F15.06 subcommittee members and all F15 main committee members is to see that they are aware of the *black humor* of (i) the consensus position of the NPGPA members of F15.06 who assert that a typical consumer (purchaser) better understands the power of a nonpowder gun when it is stated that the muzzle velocity is (say) 540 feet per second, versus when it is stated that a BB fired from this gun can penetrate up to (say) 4.7 inches into simulated human flesh, and (ii) the vice-president of Daisy who originally drafted the muzzle velocity specification in F-589 and then subsequently testified under oath in a deposition that he knew that consumers (purchasers) probably do not understand muzzle velocity. All F15 main committee members should also be aware of the excessive hazard associated with gravity-feed systems on multiple-pump guns, the safety goggles issue, the age-grading issue, the automatic safety issue, etc. The disgusting actions and positions the NPGPA members of F15.06 should not be hidden from F15 main committee members (or the public) by the ASTM staff liaison person or the F15 main committee chairman.

I demand a F15.06 letter ballot on my proposed revisions of F-589 (which *was not* included in the F15.06 minutes mailed to me, and likely were not mailed to anyone else.). I also demand the right to write to both F15.06 subcommittee members and F15 main committee members so that I can support my proposed revisions with relevant information and discussion.





BRIEF ASSESSMENT: The death of a 13-year-old boy described in IDI 980908HCN0414 wa to an accidental discharge of a Model 990 air rifle. The incident air rifle was not available for examination and testing. Two new Model 990 air rifles were purchased for testing.

RESULTS: The following tests, described in ASTM Voluntary Standard F589-92, were perfor both air rifles:

9.3 Trigger Pull Test

9.4 Safety Mechanism Test

9.5 Drop Test.

Both air rifles passed these three tests. After these tests, both air rifles were test fired and ex any anomalies. Nothing unusual was observed or exhibited during these firing tests.

Officer KS responded to the scene and found paramedics with the victim in the family room where the two cushion sofa was located, see photos # 9 & 10.

Officer KS interviewed the victim's brother and their friends. At the time the two boys gave a false story. They suggested that the victim and his brother were wrestling when he threw the victim off the couch. Paramedics indicated that this story did not hold up.

Detective C reported that there was a blood trail leading from the living room into the family room. A two cushion tan sofa facing south is located in the family room. They found a dirty white pillow on top of the two cushion sofa, see photos.

More officers arrived at the scene and the boys finally came forward with the facts. F told the officers that he shot the victim with an air rifle.

The victim was air lifted to St. Joseph's Hospital, Phoenix, Arizona. Officer BG was directed to the hospital where he met the medical staff. The victim was still being treated in the emergency room at this time.

Dr. H pronounced the victim dead at 3:35 p.m. Dr. H told Detective S that he believed the pellet entered from an angle just slightly behind the victim's right ear. This pellet traveled through the brain and stopped in the left temporal area.

Medical Examiner with Maricopa County conducted an autopsy. Detective S attended. Detective S observed an entrance wound in the victim's right ear just above the opening to the ear canal. He reported that x-rays showed a projectile in the left portion of the brain.

Medical Examiner determined that the cause of death was a gunshot (pellet) wound to the head. Her pathologic diagnosis included:

- I. Penetrating gunshot wound of head.
 - A. Distant entrance wound of right external ear.
 - B. Track through right external ear skin and cartilage, right temporalis muscle, right ear lobe, lodging in the left frontal lobe of brain.
 - C. Nondeformed, grey, small metal pellet recovered from the left anterior frontal lobe of brain.
 - D. Path of gunshot wound: Right to left, slightly upward, slightly back to front.
