IDENTIFICATION OF EXPERT WITNESSES

Respondents, Zen Magnets, LLC, and Star Networks, LLC and pursuant to this Court's July 30, 2013 Memorandum of Hearing and Scheduling Order identifies the following as their expert witnesses whom they expect to call as witnesses at any hearing in this matter.

A. Dr. Boyd Edwards, Professor of Physics, Dean and Executive Director, Utah State University Uintah Basin

Dr. Edwards is expected to testify about the educational utility of earth magnets and the Subject Products. He is expected to testify that there is great educational value of the Subject Products in teaching young people about physics in particular and earth sciences in general. He is of the view that this educational value far outweighs the potential for harm due to misuse or abuse. Dr. Edwards is also expected to testify that he himself owns numbers of sets of Zen magnets and has used them with his family and believes that there is no defect whatsoever. The factual basis of Dr. Edwards's opinion is his use of the magnets and his experience with them. That is summary of Dr. Edwards's opinion.

Produced herewith is Dr. Edwards' CV and a report he has prepared for purposes of this endorsement. These are served herewith and incorporated herein as Respondent Expert ID Exhibits A and B, respectively.

B. David A. Richter; Associate Professor; Department of Mathematics, MS 5248; Western Michigan University; Kalamazoo, MI 49008-5248; Dr. Richter is expected to testify about the utility of earth magnets. He is further expected to testify that earth magnets are not defective and that neither Zen Magnets nor Neo Balls are defective.

Professor Richter has prepared a statement for the CPSC as part of its rule-making procedures and that statement is served herewith and incorporated herein as Respondent Expert ID Exhibit C.
