This meeting was held at the request of Bruce Campbell of Wicks Unlimited to discuss possible future changes to the ASTM standard including:

- Testing both trimmed and un-trimmed candles,
- Requiring candles to cool to a certain temperature between testing, and
- Testing a sample size instead of an individual candle.
