**Summary of Meeting:**

Ballot item 2 affirm with comment: This was related to the tolerances of neoprene rods. The subcommittee recognizes that the two sections are inconsistent with each other. Neoprene rods are able to be purchased off the shelf within the parameters.

Ballot item 3 was discussed. The subcommittee agreed there should be an additional diagram to A1.31 for methodology for measuring sidewall height of a curved slide. The methodology for measuring sidewall heights would apply for slides bedways with a cross sectional geometry that is continuously curved.

Old business:

The subcommittee is thinking about incorporating the fish probe from the public playground standard for the partially bounded openings. There was agreement on adding it to the standard.

The subcommittee was proposing to make the following change (red text) to section 6.2 *acute angles*.

6.2 Acute angles—there shall be no acute angles, or group of acute angles **within accessible openings as defined in 6.1.1.**, formed by two or more members in which the legs point upward...
