### Summary of Meeting:

This meeting was convened to discuss combining UL 30, UL 1313, and ULC ORD-30 into a single, binational standard for safety containers, regardless of construction. UL prepared a summary of the requirements between the three documents and a number of recommendations and decisions for the group to consider.

Some of the decisions the group made included:

- The group agreed to harmonize on objective requirements and remove subjective requirements (e.g. remove requirements such as “good workmanship” and keep requirements with a performance test or other objective way of determining compliance).
- The group decided to add requirements for flame mitigation devices, and decided not to include any child resistance requirements. If the containers were deemed to be consumer products, they would be required to meet ASTM F2517.
- The group decided to add a performance test for the pressure relief requirement.
- Three task groups will be empaneled to review all the requirements and the group’s decisions and make specific recommendations on the text of a new document.
  - A task group to review the document scope and other non-mandatory items
  - A task group to review construction requirements
  - A task group to review performance tests

The next STP meeting will be scheduled for March 2020. The task groups are expected to start meeting in January. The time table for this group will be dependent on the need to replace/update ULC ORD-30, which may be two years from now.
