**MEETING SUMMARY:** The subcommittee discussed the results of 4 ballots that closed 11/18:

**F15 (18-10) Ballot, Item 5 WK65603** – which adds a note of clarification for the reclined seat exemption. 3 negatives disused. One negative was found persuasive but editorial the other negatives were withdrawn, so the ballot passed.

**F15 (18-10) Ballot, Item 6 WK65603**- which makes ad-hoc warning changes to toy accessories. Negative and comment were resolved, and the ballot passed.

**F15 (18-10) Ballot, Item 7 WK65603-** makes the instructional literature section on trays and tray use consistent with warning label section. One negative found to be persuasive and the ballot will be re-balloted.

**F15 (18-10) Ballot, Item 8 WK65603-** adds "front torso support" to horizontal pull testing instruction consistent with rest of standard where tray and front torso support are stated together Negative resolved, and the ballot passed.

The subcommittee chair updated the subcommittee on what occurred and was discussed at the reclined seat Task group meeting on 3/30/19 and proposed time line for developing stability requirements for reclined seat high chair products. Then the call was unexpectedly disconnected due power failure at host's location and the meeting ended.
