Summary of meeting:

CPSC staff participated in a conference call meeting held by the ASTM F15.77 subcommittee ("SC") to discuss the draft "Standard for Marketing & Labeling Magnet Sets Containing Small Loose, Powerful Magnets with a Flux Index ≥ 50 ." Main topics of discussion included:

- Suggestions from the Ad Hoc Wording document (Revision D).
- Responsibilities of manufacturers for sales and marketing.
- Inclusion of general incident and hazard information in the introduction.
- Task groups for the following: magnet performance testing, label and storage container permanence testing, warning label language and design, and instructional literature.
- Utility of forced acknowledgement warnings. Staff encouraged the use of forced acknowledgement warnings, but not in lieu of permanent warnings on the permanent storage container.
- References to appropriate ages of users. Staff cautioned that the term "children" in phrases such as, "not for children," may be ambiguous, and that specifying the age "14+" discounts the risk posed to users 14 years and older.

The subcommittee will continue to review the draft, and ASTM will circulate the revised draft with comments. A new meeting has tentatively been set for June 28, 2019.
