MEETING SUMMARY: The meeting was to initiate the periodic review of the F2923 children's jewelry voluntary standard under ASTM procedures. Topics for discussion included a proposed update to the cadmium requirement to a lower content limit, updating the reference to the nickel requirement (based on the European requirement), and adding a restriction on phthalates. The meeting also included discussion on acceptable test methods. Next steps: another meeting will be scheduled to continue the discussion, and build consensus on changes to the standard, in anticipation of the formal ASTM process for review and balloting the revised standard.
