**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

Ms. Carter presented background for the task group and stated she was using the meeting to brainstorm. She stated that the Infant Sleep Standard was being developed as a general standard to address new sleep products coming on the market. She explained that the standard would state that an infant sleep product should meet one of the four current sleep product regulations and if it doesn't meet those regulations then it would have to meet this "general standard" being developed. Ms. Kish stated that from the CPSC's perspective, if a new infant sleep product doesn't meet the 4 traditional sleep product regulations, then it should meet bassinets.

Ms. Carter then presented a spreadsheet with comparison requirements across Playard/Non-full-size cribs, cribs, bassinets, and bedside sleepers. She talked about which requirements were found in which standards and the need to include them as general requirements in the Infant Sleep Product standard. Areas in which more discussion is required are:

- \*Stability
- \*Mattress features
- \*Side height
- \*Side material
- \*Rail latching

Ms. Carter stated that she will present the results of the meeting at the November 10, 2020 subcommittee. The meeting adjourned.
