### MEETING SUMMARY:

Rachel Weintraub of Consumer Federation of America, chaired the meeting and the meeting started with a discussion of the balance of the committee. One additional producer was required to join the committee to balance it. Two representatives from a manufacturer on the call said they had not yet joined the committee, but were planning to. At the previous meeting, it was of particular concern that test labs participate in the committee – a representative from Intertek (a test lab) was present on the call.

The committee next moved to a discussion of the structure of the proposed standard, and the task groups that could provide support in writing each section. Three groups were proposed:

1. Scope/Definitions
2. Performance Requirements
3. Training/Instructions/Warnings

There was some discussion of the various safety systems and operational limits that could be present in the performance requirements. Structural and material quality requirements were only briefly touched on.

At the end of the meeting, participants on the call were asked to volunteer to participate in a task group. CPSC staff volunteered to participate in each of the three proposed task groups.

The dates of the next committee and task group meetings are to be determined.
