China proposed a new ISO project on establishing a new committee on consumer product safety management. This meeting was called by ANSI to allow stakeholders to discuss the proposal and ask questions in anticipation of a future US position on this proposed new ISO project. ANSI will not develop a position on the proposal as a result of this meeting, but instead want stakeholders to submit written comments by December 11, 2020 which ANSI will use to develop a US position by January 14, 2021.

Stakeholders voiced their comments on the proposal, while the comments were not cataloged it appeared that most of the commenters were not in favor of the proposal and many commented that the scope was not well developed and too broad.

One stakeholder asked for CPSC to provide information on how CPSC works with other foreign consumer product safety agencies and if this proposal would impact those relationships. CPSC staff will review the proposal and provide feedback to ANSI if needed.
