## **SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

The group introduced a new subcommittee vice chair to aid in the development of the e-scooter ride share standard.

Then, the group discussed the self-balancing scooter draft standard. On the previous ballot, there were negatives found persuasive. The group discussed negatives and comments in order to prepare for a re-ballot. Examples of revisions include rewording safety labeling and instructions to be consistent with ASTM ad-hoc safety instructions and language.

The subcommittee will need to review the children's scooter standards:

- ASTM F2642, Consumer Safety Specification for Recreational Powered Scooters and Pocket Bikes
- ASTM F2642, Consumer Safety Specification for Safety Instructions and Labeling for Recreational Powered Scooters and Pocket Bikes.

The subtask group working on the adult e-scooter draft standard provided an update on the progress. The subtask group divided into smaller task groups to work on specific requirements and sections of the draft standard.

The next meeting is scheduled for May.
