SUMMARY OF MEETING:

CPSC staff attended the joint ASTM F15.53 and F15.55 working group meeting for ASTM F2369, *Standard Safety Specification for Non-integral Firearm Locking Devices*, and ASTM F2456, *Standard Specification for You-Resistant Firearms Containers (YRFCs)*, respectively. The working group discussed improvements to various test methods including lock picking, impact tests, and a new trigger lock torque test. The group developed language for default biometric recognition features for the product as received new by the consumer. Additional work will be performed to continue to develop the test methods and evaluate proposed test criteria. The next working group meeting is TBD.
