**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

Mr. Crowley presented the task group (TG) with a proposal to change the title of the standard to “Infant Sleep Products” and there were no objections from the TG. He then presented a changed introduction that simply removed the word “inclined” from the current introduction to F3118; there were no objections. The rest of the meeting was spent discussing the scope and whether specific product designs should be listed or if a different approach should be used to describe infant sleep products intended to be covered by the standard. The group agreed that two definitions were required in order to form the direction of the standard: “sleep products” and “infant” (specifically should 5 months be used or an older age). The TG acknowledged that this standard is intended to be a core base for infant sleep products. Ms. Lynyak stated that in another ASTM group there is a similar core standard and she is researching how the core standard is used with other standards. She will share the results with the TG as soon as she has them. Mr. Crowley requested another TG meeting be calendared for two weeks. The meeting adjourned.
