SUMMARY OF MEETING: CFA and KID requested a call with Commissioner Baiocco to discuss the proposed Final Rule: Infant Sleep Products. At the start of the call, Commissioner Baiocco stated that she does not generally discuss matters pending a vote, but since the Commission has received a number of comments from various stakeholders beyond the comment period, she agreed to accept the call to receive information. CFA and KID reiterated their support for the proposed final rule on infant sleep products. They stated that in-bed sleepers and infant sleep products that do not currently meet a mandatory safety standard could be made safer, but also stated that requiring those products to meet the current bassinet and cradle standard should be made mandatory. Commissioner Baiocco thanked them for their time and attention to this matter.
