SUMMARY OF MEETING: Mr. Ware (subcommittee chair) conducted the meeting. The task group discussed:

- 1. Ballot results for the locking/latching ballot. One negative vote indicated that the member's product "folds" in such a way that a lock/latching mechanism is not possible nor necessary. The member submitted to Mr. Ware several emails with documentation to demonstrate his position.**
- 2. TG Lead suggested possibly added an exemption for the product in question.**
- 3. CPSC staff pointed out that the proposed wording "other means to prevent collapse" actually allows the product to meet the requirement.**

- 4. CPSC staff suggested possibly defining "collapse" to make it clear when a product meets the requirement.**
- 5. Mr. Ware will do more research and will discuss at subcommittee meeting in November.**
