SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The subject meeting was the annual subcommittee meeting lead by Sub Chairs Nancy Cowles and Julie Froelicher. The meeting began with two presentations of data. The first, from Rocky Mountain Poison Control and Drug Center (RMPDS), displaying a review of 2020 National Poison Data System (NPDS) involving unintentional exposures to children younger than 6 years. The report indicated that the overall exposures counts in 2020 were similar to the baseline period exposures. Comparisons between the baseline through December 2020 data included severity of exposures, percentage of Health Care Facility admissions, age of person involved, and routes of exposure.

The second presentation, from CPSC, provided clarification to the products categorized as Soaps and Detergents from the “Effect of Novel Coronavirus Pandemic on 2020 NEISS Estimates.” Staff provided a list and summary count of incidents by code for the years 2019 and 2020.

Next, members heard status reports from the Data, Scope, and Additional Measures task group leaders who summarized the most recent 2021 meetings. Afterward, members discussed the future options for the standard: renewal, revisions, or withdraw. A motion was passed to ballot the standard for renewal and continue efforts for potential improvements/revisions to the standard through incident data analysis. Committee members expressed desire for more frequent meetings with more collaboration between task groups. A doodle poll will be sent to schedule the next meeting for December 2021.
