SUMMARY OF MEETING: CPSC staff attended some of the AATCC Fall Committee meetings, hosted both virtually and in person on November 15, 2021.

RA43, Professional Textile Care, Chair of this committee did not show. A future meeting to discuss the solvents and procedures used in AATCC TM 158 was mentioned.

RA88, Home Laundering, discussed potential revisions to LP1 including adding a detergent to water ratio for amount of detergent to use rather than two specific detergent amounts for different load sizes and water levels and specifying in LP1 for one rinse cycle that has been assumed.

RA109, Flammability, discussed the inter-lab testing for update to D6413, and potential meeting alignment with ASTM D13.52

RA111, Electronically Integrated Textiles, discussed updates from other voluntary standard etextile groups, potential meeting alignment with ASTM D13.50 subcommittee meetings, and the need to find a new chair for RA111.

RA113, Emerging Issues, discussed updates to new Monograph 14 for general purpose textile face coverings for adults to include appendix with guidance for children's face coverings
