This was a meeting of the full UL 1370 STP, which covers unvented alcohol-burning fireplaces that are at least 100lb in weight, wall-mounted, or designed as existing masonry fireplace inserts. This meeting was a continuation of the November 23, 2021 UL 1370 STP meeting. Prior to November, staff had not participated in a UL 1370 STP meeting in several years.

UL 1370 was recently balloted and received no comments. The standard is being combined with ULC S674 to make a binational standard. The ballot passed; however, internal UL quality control found a number of technical issues. The STP will need to resolve the issues and re-ballot the standard. The UL STP chair identified several inconsistencies and ambiguities from combining UL 1370 and the ULC 674 standard. The STP discussed many of these inconsistencies and ambiguities during the November 23, 2021 meeting.

Prior to this meeting, UL sent out a revised draft of the standard with updates from the previous meeting. During this meeting, the STP discussed the proposed revisions with active participation from staff.

The STP did not complete the review of the draft document. UL will schedule another meeting for later in December.
