SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The task group is continuing to update and refine proposed language for ASTM F2970-22 *Standard Practice for Design, Manufacture, Installation, Operation, Maintenance, Inspection and Major Modification of Trampoline Courts* while the previously discussed updates are out for ballot (ballot F24 (22-05), item 8, closing date October 3, 2022).

The task group began reviewing the initial comments and negatives for the open ballot item. The group found comments regarding the proposed addition of a supervision plan persuasive: the commenter noted that the wording of the revision suggested that owners/operators can develop a supervision plan which specifies fewer court attendants than the minimum specified by the manufacturer. The task group revised this language to specify that owners/operators must develop a supervision plan which considers the minimum number of court attendants specified by the manufacturers, as well as other factors. The task group agreed that this section of the standard required further attention, and would revisit the topic at a future meeting. Other comments highlighted issues with the training or experience level of court attendants for Class 3 trampoline courts (performance trampolines), and with controlling access to Class 3 trampoline courts.

The task group will continue reviewing comments and negatives at future meetings, and also plans to discuss the points raised by staff in previous meetings, beginning with a discussion of requirements related to controlling access to the trampoline court. The next task group meeting is expected to take place on September 15.
