### **Summary of Meeting:**

Staff monitored the ASHRAE 62.2 Standard of Ventilation and Acceptable Indoor Air Quality in Residential Buildings subcommittee meeting. The committee discussed ventilation requirements in bedrooms without windows. Since the pandemic, there is interest in converting unused office space to residential space. Converted office space may require bedrooms to lack windows. The subcommittee discussed what ventilation requirements would be needed but did not reach consensus.

The subcommittee also discussed ventilation requirements as related to infectious aerosols. The subcommittee did not reach consensus.

The subcommittee finally discussed range hood requirements. AHAM is leading a group that is exploring nominal installed airflow, capture efficiency, and sound. More work is needed to assess the potential impact.
