Notes: Unleaded Kids expressed their interest in a review of lead requirements for both toys and for paints, and sought clarifications on process to add a review to the annual Operating Plan, as well as processes for providing information to such a review and on detection limits for current equipment. CPSC staff noted that the annual Operating Plan was in development, drawing upon inputs at the annual Priorities Hearing as well as discussions with Commissioners, staff evaluations and other sources, and that a proposed and publicly available draft would go to the Commission later in the fiscal year. CPSC staff noted that any review would likely include a call for stakeholder input, with a mechanism for providing data, research and other information to be specified. Staff further noted that detection limits were a function of not only equipment but test method.
