Summary of Meeting:

Reviewed key points from last meeting on April 12, 2024.

Reviewed NFPA 855 - Standard for the Installation of Energy Storage Systems and determined that NFPA 855 does not cover batteries in appliances.

International Fire Code (IFC) does have storage battery limit. There will be IFC and International Residential Code (IRC) discussion on batteries in October.

UL 9540 (Energy Storage System (ESS) Requirements) & UL 9540A (Battery Energy Storage System testing and certification) are very active on batteries for appliances. There are currently not any Nationally Recognized Testing Labs (NRTL) that are allowed to certify to UL 9540A

UL 60730 discussion for Class B vs Class C control designation. The potential need for the use of Class C designation to protect for overtemperature conditions was discussed.

UL1973 - Standard for Batteries for Use in Stationary, Vehicle Auxiliary Power and Light Electric Rail (LER) Applications. Portions of this standard may be useful in developing the requirements for batteries in appliances.

<u>Action item</u> : WG to respond with which Sub-WG they would like to participate on – batteries or appliances.
