Notice of Proposed Rulemaking: Amendment to Requirements for Consumer Registration of Durable Infant or Toddler Products (Briefing package dated September 26, 2018, OS No. 5669)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to approve publication in the Federal Register, as drafted, a notice of proposed rulemaking to amend the existing rule, codified at 16 C.F.R. part 1130, Requirements for Consumer Registration of Durable Infant or Toddler Products. Pursuant to section 104(d) of the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (CPSIA), the proposed rule would amend the definition of "durable infant or toddler product" in the regulation to include the full statutory definition; clarify that the scope of each listed product category is further defined in the applicable mandatory standard; clarify listed product categories using the product name in the applicable mandatory standard; and clarify the scope of the infant carriers and bassinets and cradles product categories.
