**Commissioner Kaye Amendment to the *Federal Register* Notice
for the Public Hearing on Fiscal Years 2018 and 2019 Commission Agenda and Priorities**

On page 3, in section 3, delete the question mark and add the following language at the end of the sentence: ", consistent with the Plan for Retrospective Review of Existing Rules adopted by the Commission on April 1, 2016?"

On page 3, add the following language to the beginning of section 4: "The CPSC's programs will align with the strategic goals outlined in the CPSC's 2016-2020 Strategic Plan."

On page 3, line 11, delete the phrase "establishes four agency priorities," and replace it with "is based on four agency priorities"

On page 3, add the following language to the end of section 4: "The Commission also requests comments on whether the Commission should consider making any changes or adjustments to the agency's proposed or ongoing safety standards activities, regulation and enforcement efforts in fiscal years 2018 and 2019, keeping in mind the CPSC's existing policy on establishing priorities for Commission action (16 C.F.R. § 1009.8). Comments are welcome on whether particular action items should be higher priority than others, should not be included, or should be added to the fiscal year 2018 and/or fiscal year 2019 agendas."
