ITEM:

Final Rule: Safety Standard for Children's Folding Chairs and Stools
(Briefing package dated November 29, 2017, OS No. 3706)

DECISION:

The Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to approve publication in the Federal Register, as drafted, a final rule that will:

- incorporate by reference the voluntary standard, ASTM F2613-17a *Standard Consumer Safety Specification for Children's Chairs and Stools*, as the mandatory federal safety standard, but limits the scope of the standard to children's folding chairs and stools;
- amend the Commission's regulation regarding third party conformity assessment bodies to include the mandatory standard for children's folding chairs and stools in the list of notices of requirements issued by the Commission; and
- amend the product registration rule to add children's folding stools as a durable infant or toddler product for purposes of consumer product registration requirements.
