MEETING SUMMARY:

The Rational Task Group (RTG) continued its earlier work for details on the purpose, description and intent on clauses in the UL 2900-2-1 and why they are included, which is laid out in the RTG separate matrix document.

More details were added to UL 2900-2-1 clauses 12.3.2-20.6 for more clarity, correctness, and updating to current industry definitions and terms. Some of the topics discussed for the overall document included:

Whitelisting software and applications when usage is feasible; when proactive and reactive endpoint malware protection is used; software development tool chains details added as part of the purchasing and quality management system; deletion of third party software from vulnerability reports reference; and updating the Open Web Application Security Project reference.

At the May 1 virtual meeting, the review of the RTG's updated rationales was completed. The Alignment Task Group's work was also completed and will be posted to CSDS for review before balloting.
