APPEAL OF THE INITIAL DECISION**

ORDERED that the Commission and its individual members, Chairman Kaye and Commissioner Adler, Robinson, and Mohorovic, are disqualified from hearing the appeal of the Initial Decision in CPSC Docket 12-2 because of both prejudgment of law and fact and biased statements made against Respondent and the Subject Products.
